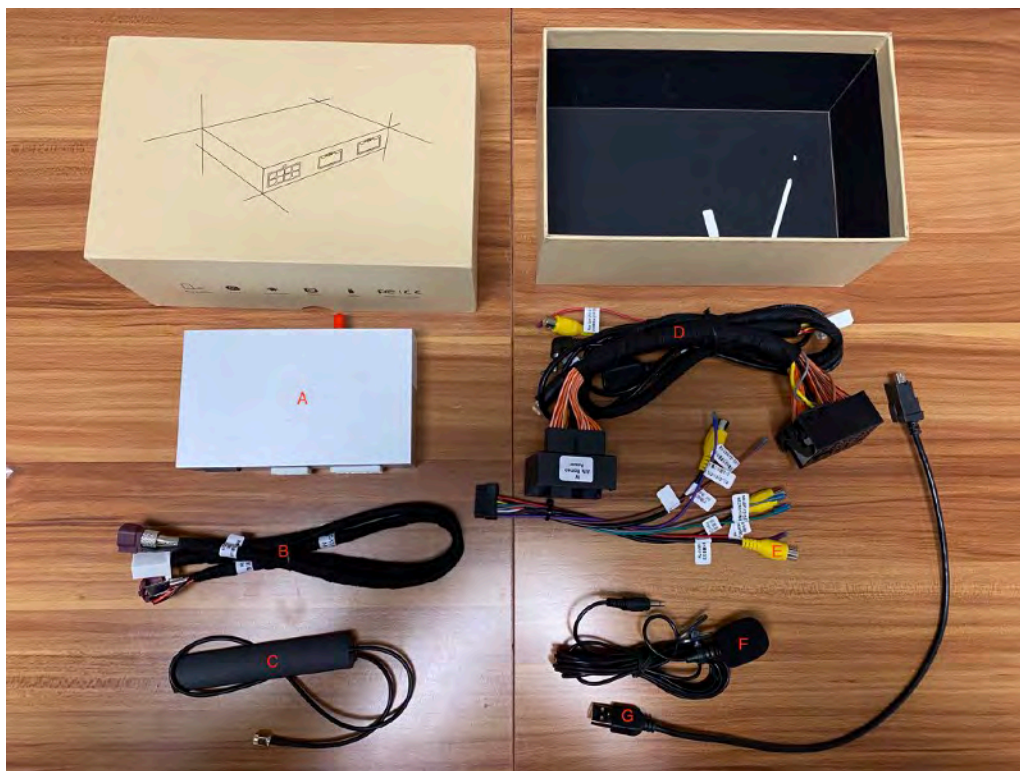


## Alfa Romeo Wireless CarPlay Kit Installation



A: Main unit  
B: Video feed cable

D: main harness  
E: backup camera harness, we will not use in this case

C: Wireless Anentana

F: Microphone

G: USB cable



Will need couple hand tools:  
a small hook with handle  
a magnate pan to help fishing cable through  
T20 and T30 Torx bit drive for screw removal  
and a plastic trim removal tool







Before you start, find out the size of your factory screen, and set switches accordingly.



Everything we need to remove will be under driver side of the dashboard.









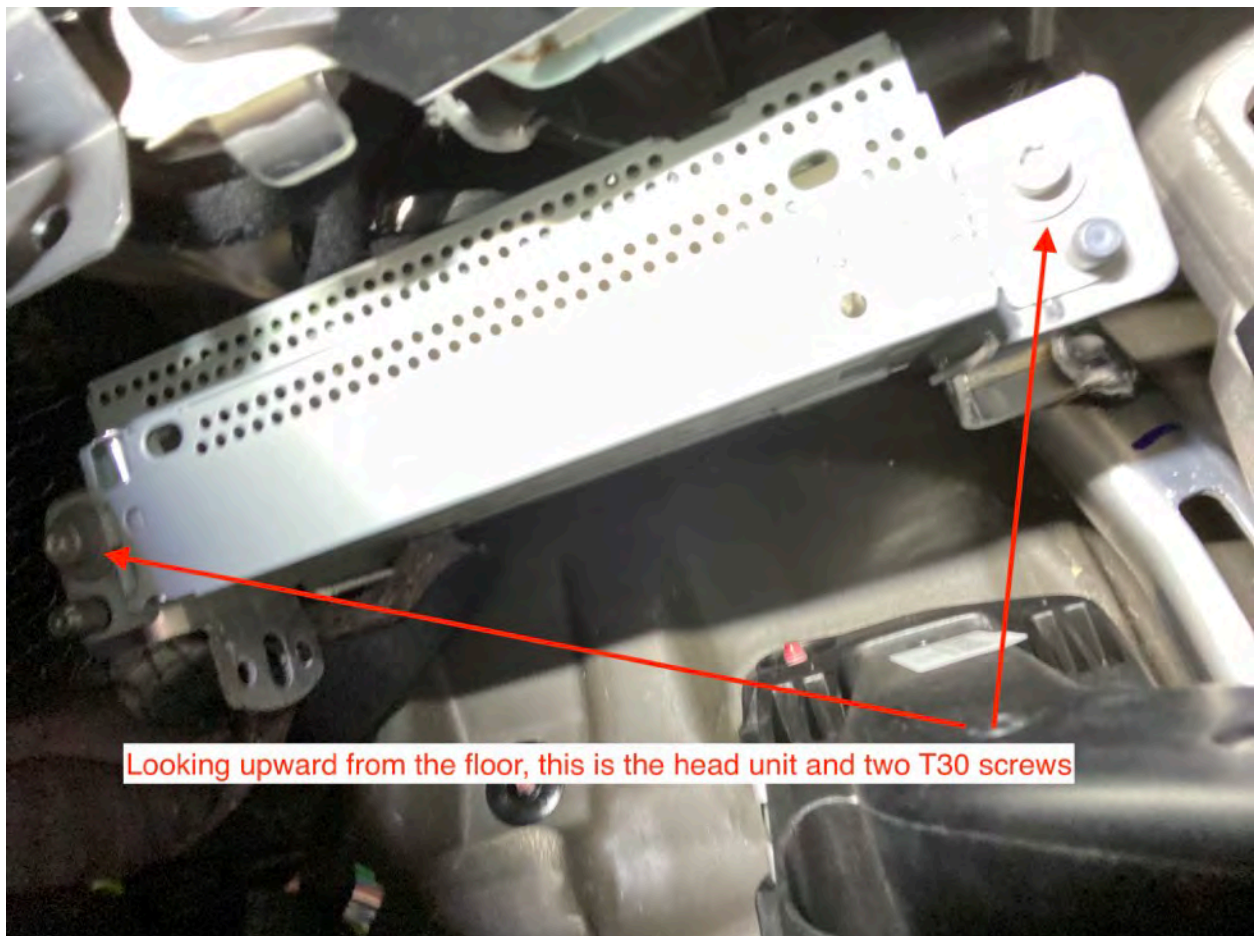




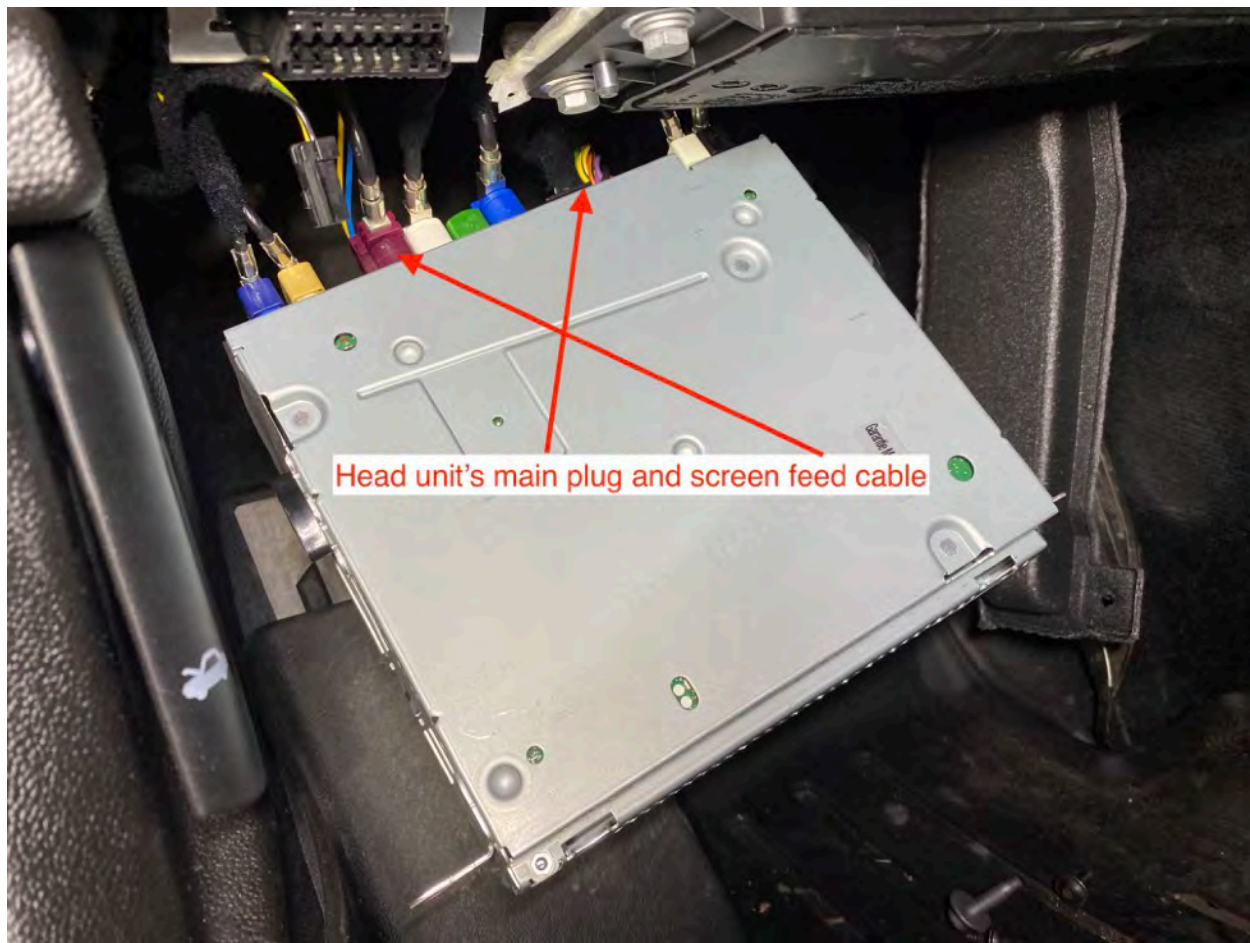










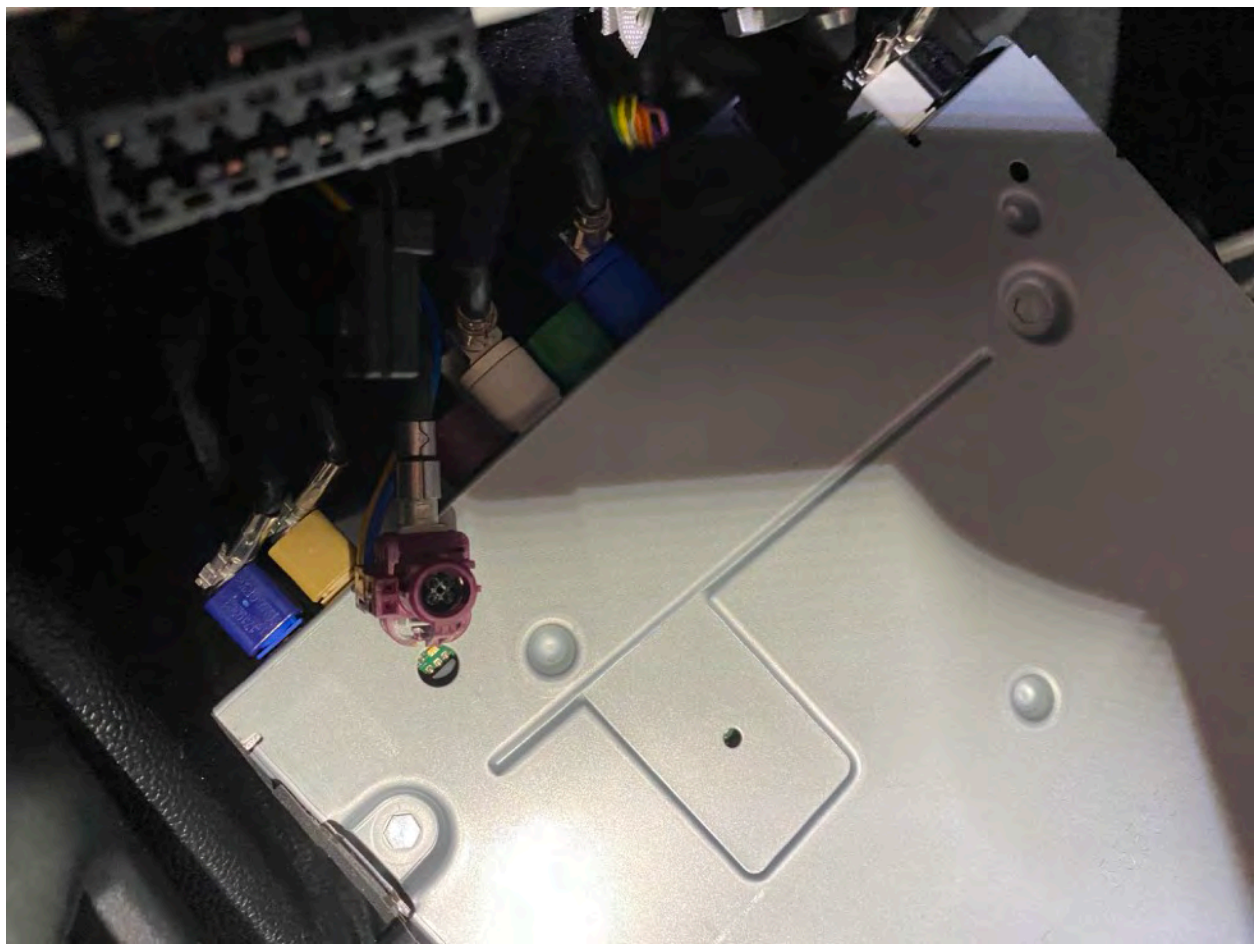


Head unit's main plug and screen feed cable

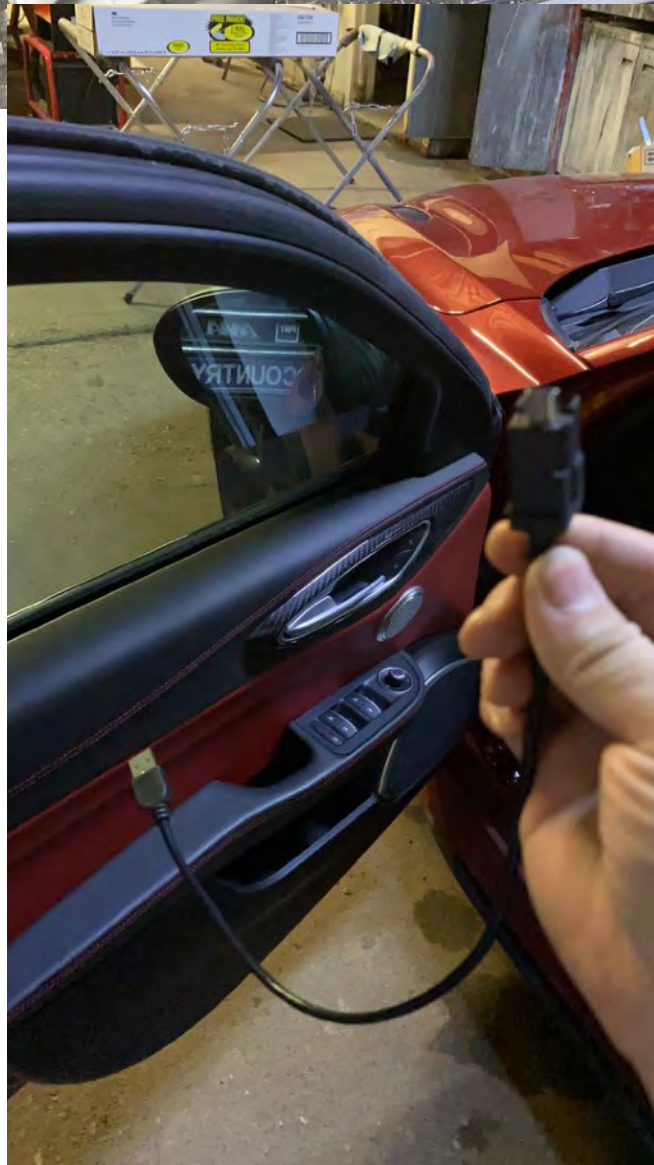


there is a clip back of the connector  
please refer to the both connector from hardness D











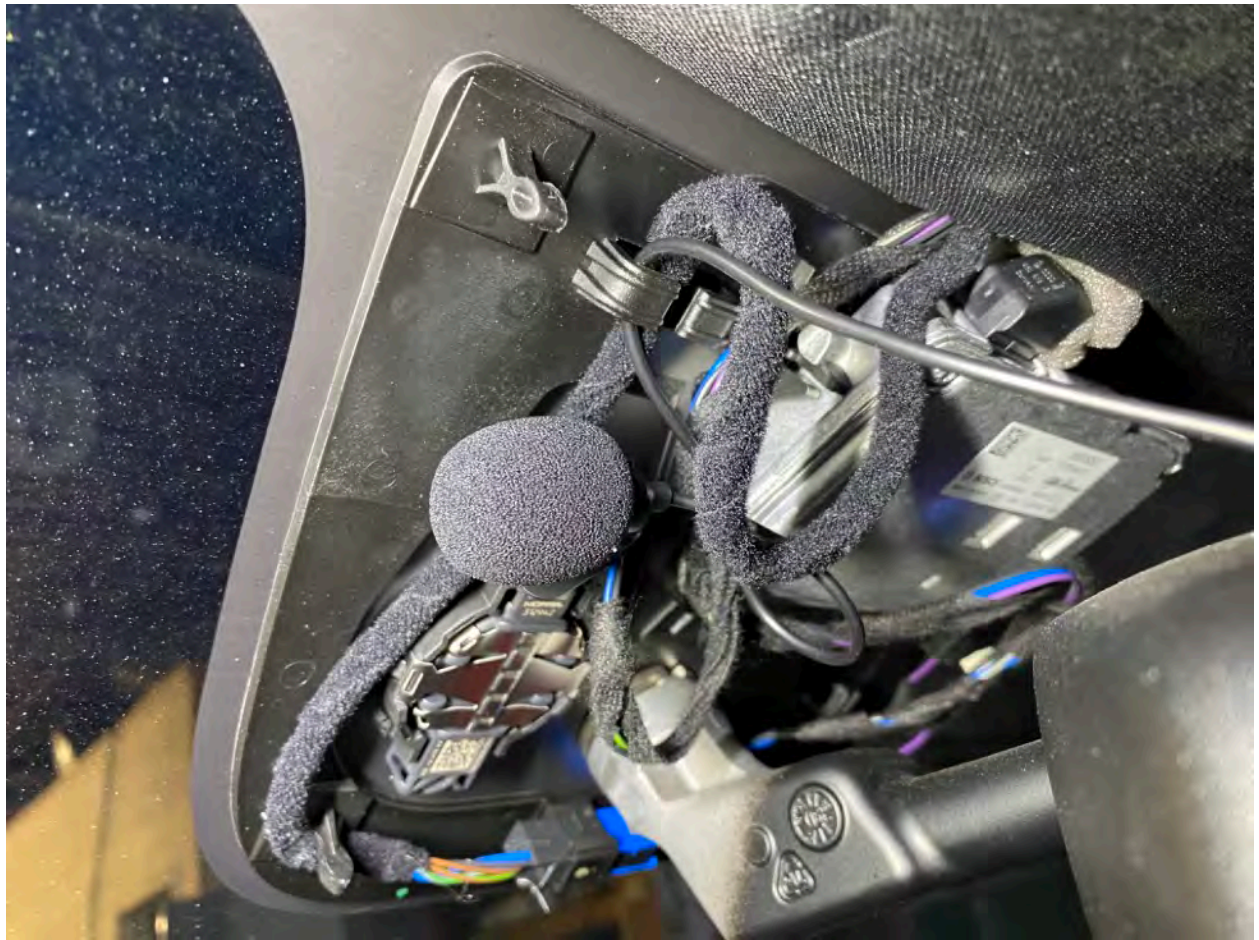




This step we are placing the microphone for carplay voice command to work. there are two ways to place it, first one will be bit difficult but permanent First need to unclip the cover behind the rear view mirror, place the mic behind the slot opening















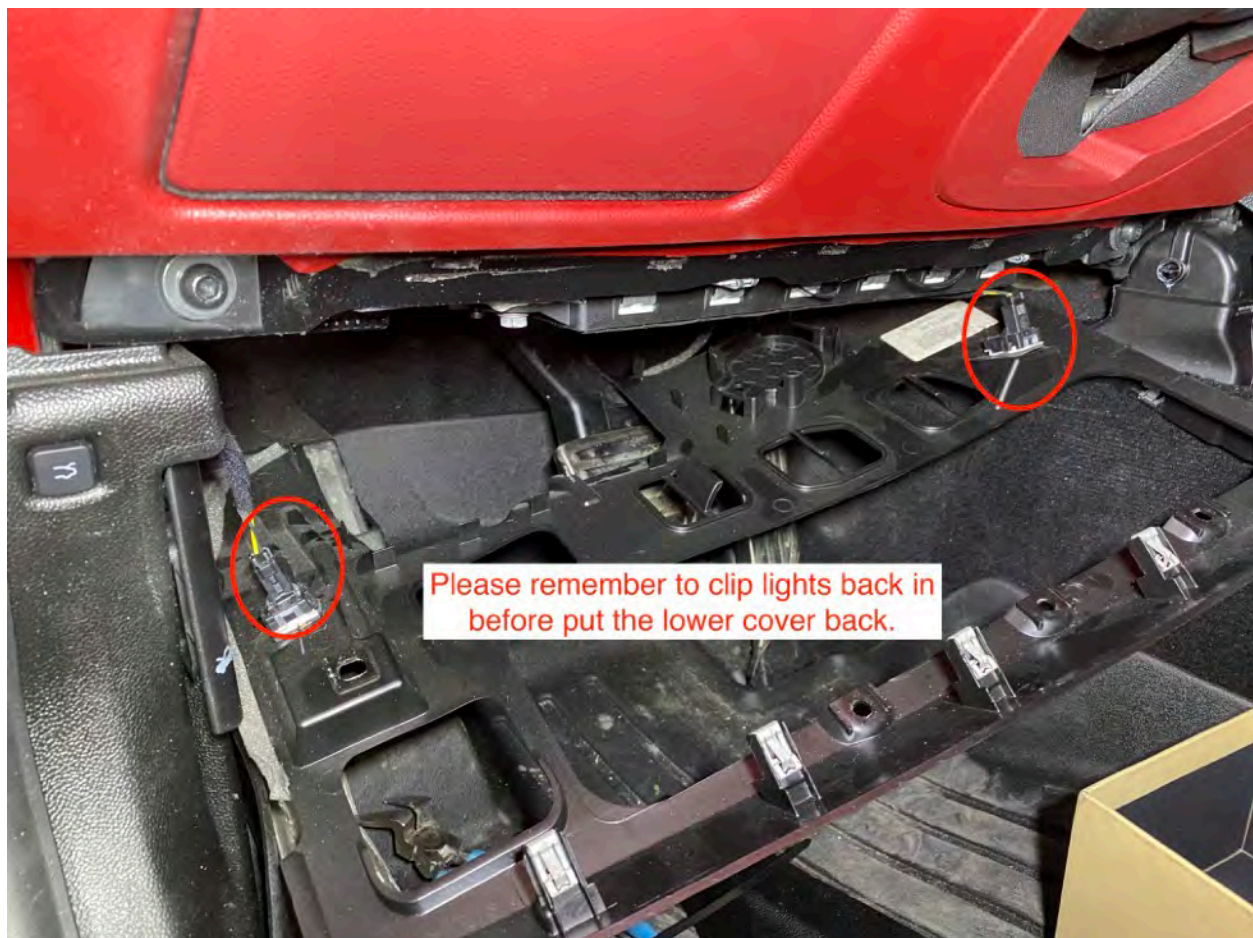
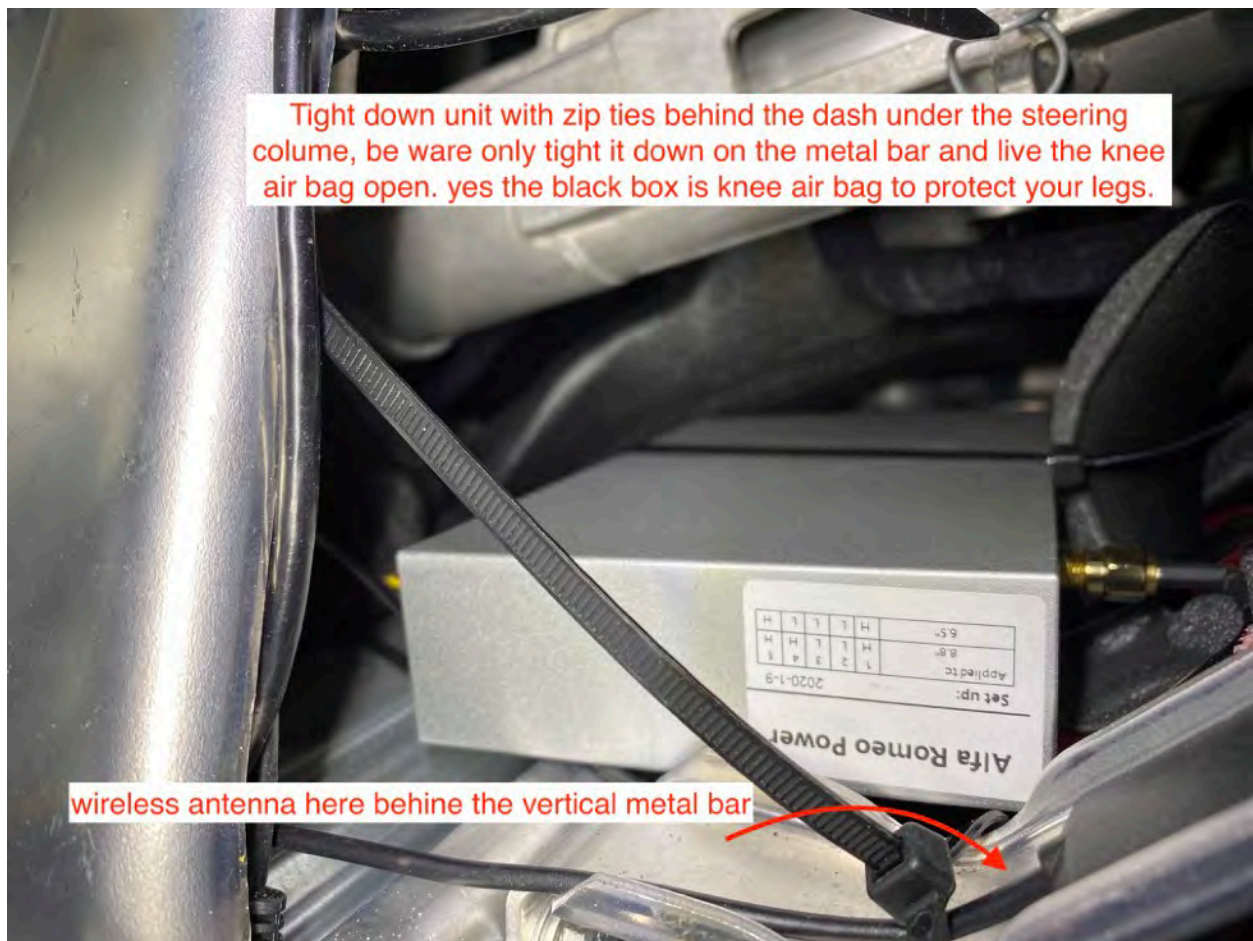
Continue running the cable down and go back to unit











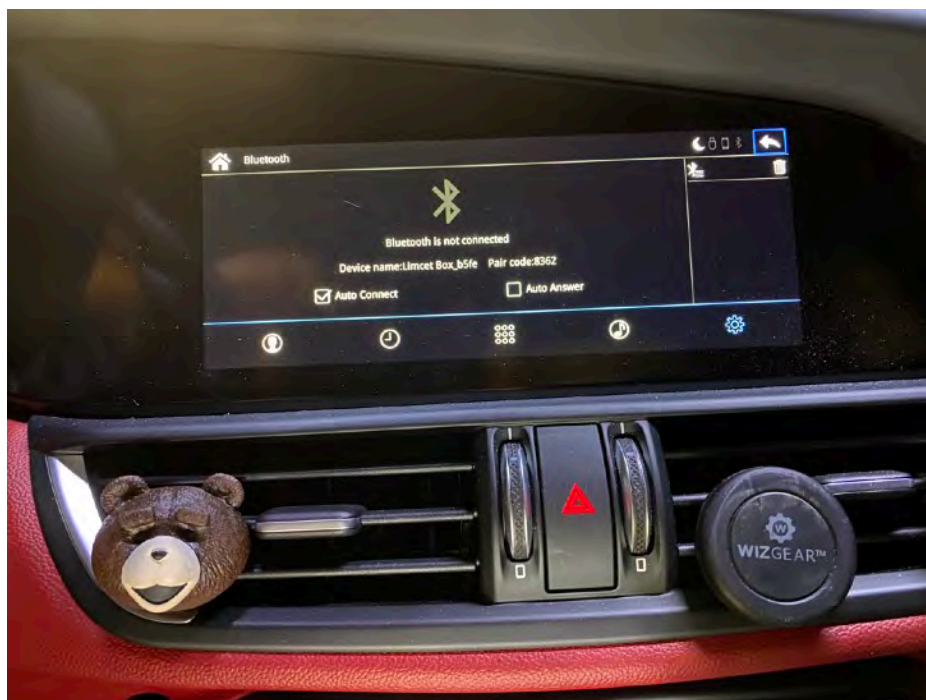


## Setup Process

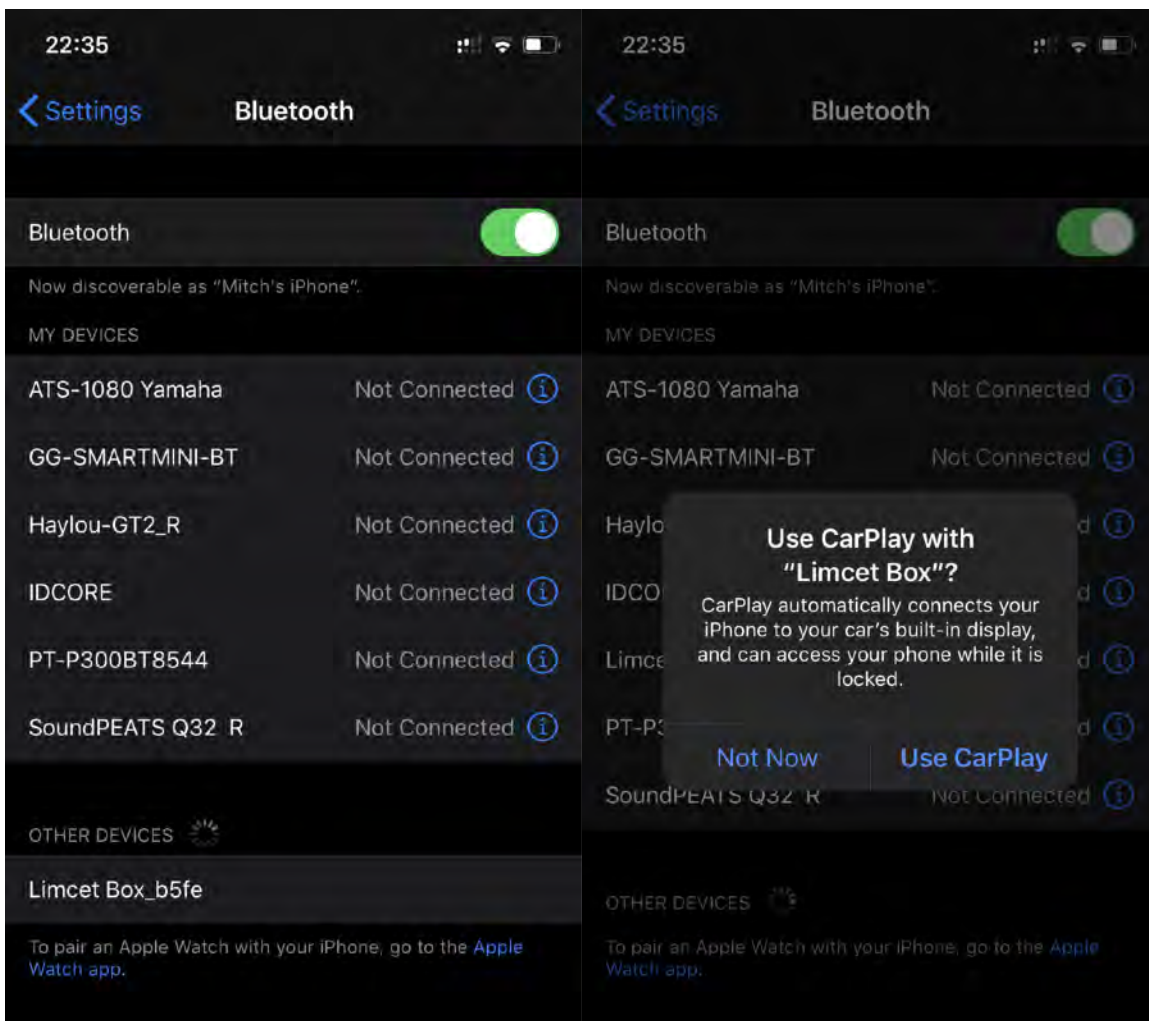
After start the car, long press menu bottom and you will get this screen



Select bluetooth, pair your phone









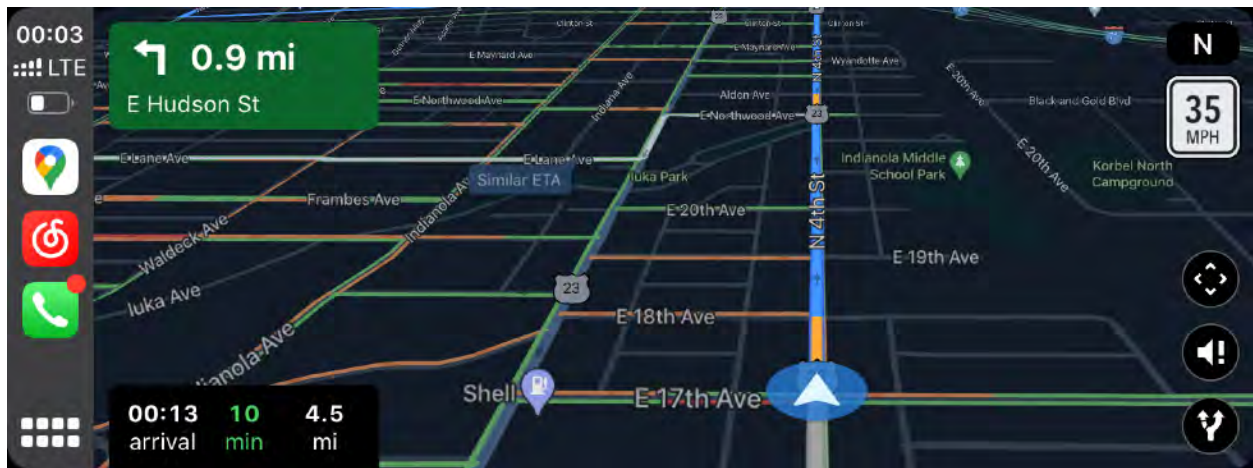
In case there is no sound, press menu bottom and jump back to factory screen,



Select AUX input in media setting and take it in AUX at all time when you using CarPlay.

FYI, the very first time you get wireless connection, the response will be a bit slow as data transfer take some bandwidth.

simply turn off the car and lock it for 5 mins. Next time when you step in the car, wireless connection will establish itself, the operation will be very smooth with no delay.
