

## *Instruction Guide*

*Select iPod by selecting the CD changer mode, this button may be “Source”, “CD”, “Mode” or “CDC”, dependent upon vehicle.*

*To change playlist use either the disc preset buttons or disc up/down (dependent upon head unit). To use the preset buttons, check which disc number is displayed on the head unit, then using the next or previous preset button will move the playlist forward or backwards.*

*To change track, simply use the track forward/backward buttons. The display will show track number 1, 2, 3 etc. and will keep looping.*

*The iPod will charge when the head unit is switched on and will power down when the head unit or ignition are switched off.*

*If your car is fitted with factory steering wheel controls these can be used to operate the iPod in the same way as the head unit controls.*
